**VIEW ROUNDABOUT TRUCK DRIVING TEST**

The Council and staff traveled to an area of vacant property near Manning Avenue and Golden State Boulevard to view a truck driving test on a simulated traffic roundabout. Several vehicles, including trucks with long trailers, a school bus, and a City fire truck, test drove the model roundabout. The test was to help determine whether it would be feasible to install a roundabout near the Merced and 10th Street intersection for traffic mitigation purposes. Councilmember Hammer left the site at 3:40 p. m.

The Council discussed and asked questions of the City Engineer and CalTrans representatives who were present. The consensus was to place the matter on the next agenda for further discussion.
