

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE EXPANSION  
OF THE BOUNDARIES OF A GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY AGENCY**

South Kings Groundwater Sustainability Agency

Notice is hereby given that the South Kings Groundwater Sustainability Agency ("South Kings GSA"), a joint powers authority whose membership is currently comprised of the Cities of Sanger, Parlier, Fowler, Selma, and Kingsburg, will hold a public hearing regarding the adoption of a Resolution of Intent to expand the boundaries of the South Kings GSA, as set forth in the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act, Part 2.74 of Division 6 of the California Water Code (commencing with Section 10720). The South Kings GSA is within the Kings Sub-basin (Sub-basin no. 5-22.08) of the San Joaquin Valley Groundwater Basin, as described in California Department of Water Resources Bulletin 118 (2016 update). The South Kings GSA will be considering the addition of the service boundaries of the Del Rey Community Services District and the Caruthers Community Services District to the overall boundaries of the South Kings GSA. The public hearing is for the purpose of reviewing and providing explanation of the proposal, and allowing public input on the expansion of the South Kings GSA.
