

### What businesses are permitted to open on Friday, June 12, 2020 in Fresno County?

The Fresno County Department of Public Health (FCDPH) has reviewed ten (10) additional business sectors for opening in Variance Counties with approval of the County Health Officer. The FCDPH is approving 9 of the 10 sectors for reopening on June 12, 2020. This will require that each business operation fully implement and adhere to <u>statewide industry guidance to reduce risk</u>.

## What businesses/ industries are not allowed to open on June 12, 2020?

As we plan to transition into this phase, the FCDPH remains concerned about the increasing trend of positive cases in Fresno County. As a result, the FCDPH is postponing the opening of the Movie Theaters and Family Entertainment Centers sector. This sector is tentatively scheduled to reopen on June 26, 2020 and each business will require a site-specific plan prior to reopening. Because the number of new cases and fatalities in our county suggest that we are still not seeing evidence of "flattening the curve" we believe it is prudent to postpone reopening this sector, which will give the FCDPH and our business community additional time to prepare for a safe reopening.

Included below is a list of industries opening including specific coverage and if a submission of attestation to FCDPH will be required to open:
