


HOW TO NAVIGATE THE INTERACTIVE MAP

The *Interactive Land Use Map tab* allows you to view the proposed land use map in greater detail than the *Proposed Land Use Changes tab*. Selecting a parcel on the map will bring up additional information in the panel on the right, including the opportunity to add comments about the selected parcel. While much of the current general plan designations for the City Limits and Planning Area will be staying the same, some Change Areas and Growth Areas are proposed. The *Common Terms tab* outlines these various types of changes as well as other technical terms that are helpful to understand in more detail.

Selecting Parcels

Parcels can be found and selected in three ways:


- **Navigating the map and clicking directly on a parcel.** The map can be navigated with the tools on the left of the original view. The plus and minus buttons zoom (a mouse wheel or track pad can also zoom) and the house returns the view to its original position. Clicking and dragging allow you to pan around the map.
Searching by address in the search bar on the upper left. Addresses can be entered in the search bar to zoom directly to a parcel (this will zoom to the parcel, but you will still need to select the parcel by clicking on it).
- **Scrolling to the correct APN on the list to the right of the map.**



Adding Comments

After clicking the parcel, more information will be shown to the right of the map, including the Assessor Parcel Number (APN), current General Plan (GP) land use designation, proposed General Plan land use designation, address (if one is assigned), area the parcel is located in (Unchanged Area, Change Area, or Growth Area), and size of the parcel in acres.

To add a comment, click the speech bubble in the information panel after selecting a parcel. Clicking the speech bubble will open a box with different fields to type in. The name and contact fields are optional, but we encourage you to provide your information so that we can clarify comments if needed. Comments are not public and will not be shown on the map during the comment period.



TROUBLESHOOTING

- If content on the story maps tabs is overlapping on your screen, reduce the zoom of your browser. If viewing the document on your phone, maps are most visible in landscape mode.
- If you are having trouble selecting a parcel, clear your previous selection by clicking the back button on the information panel and clicking anywhere on the map outside of the City.
