Pursuant of section 2-2.206 of the City of Fowler Code of Ordnances, the Recreation Commission shall hold meetings at least once each month, at a time and place set by resolution, and shall adopt rules for the conduct of business and shall instruct the secretary to keep accurate record of its minutes, resolutions, transactions, and other business. Such records shall be a public record and shall be maintained in the office of the City Clerk. All meetings shall be open to the public and shall abide by the provisions of the Ralph M. Brown Act. A majority of the Commission shall constitute a quorum for the conduct of business. (Ord. 78-1, 4-5-78)

Pursuant to the notice of meeting duly given, a meeting of the City of Fowler Recreation Commission was held on Tuesday, June 13, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. in person at the City of Fowler City Council Chambers located at 128 South 5th Street, Fowler, Ca. 93625.

1. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

3. PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS

There being no presentations from the public in person or via teleconference, this portion of the meeting was concluded.

4. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Chairman Rico-Vasquez directed the Commission's attention to the minutes of the May 9, 2023 Recreation Commission Meeting. There being no further additions, and upon motion by Commissioner Mejia and second by Commissioner Velasquez-Lopez, the following resolution was approved unanimously.

5. BUDGET

At the council meeting dated June 6, 2023, our budget was approved for the next fiscal year in the amount of \$60,000. This amount will cover all six events. And the budget includes Wednesday Night at the Park, event banners. Recreation Department Supervisor will present an itemized budget per event for the next commission meeting. Commissioners discussed sponsorships for city events. A discussion ensued regarding an increase in next year's budget in hopes to expand our resources for potential new events.

6. 4th OF JULY

Commissioners are asked to meet at the football field at 8:00am for set up and return at 5 pm. A Plexiglass donation box will be located at the entrance and under supervision of the

commissioners during the event. Gates open at 6 pm, and commissioners came to consensus on an event rotation schedule. The City will provide waivers for the fun zone. Boy Scouts will present the colors at 7:45, and Jordon Martinez will sing the national anthem.

7. CHRISTMAS ON MERCED ST

The event date is Wednesday, December 6th. We will welcome Santa, The Grinch, and a train ride to join us at the event. Commissioners are encouraged to come to the next meeting with ideas for this event.

8. MOVIE NIGHT IN THE PARK

Mayor Pro Tem Mejia gave an update on the status of the Lions Club movie night. The event will take place on October 6th. Commissioners discussed collaborating with other organizations to hold a movie night in the future. Possible event ideas included a movie in PJs, Christmas movie night, and other winter-themed options. A date will be discussed at the next meeting.

9. COMMISSIONER REPORTS AND COMMENTS

Commissioner Khasigian brought up an idea for a 4th of July raffle with the boy scouts. Recreation Department Supervisor reminded commissioners; Wednesday Night at the Park will kick off on August 2nd.
