Station 101 Coverage

This year, 2023, we have had an engine covering Station 101 a total of 18 times.

- Not all the apparatuses arrived in the city, but moved into the area during times of drawdown. Some got food in town and were released before making it to the station.
- Others started heading into the area and were diverted to a new call.
- 11 of the 18 arrived and stayed at the Station.
- The longest cover assignment was 30 mins.

ISO 2023 Review

ISO stands for Insurance Services Office. Fire Departments are reviewed every 5 years.

Areas of review - Emergency Communication Systems; Fire Departments, covering personnel, capabilities, training, equipment, etc.; Water Supply; and Community Risk Reduction.

After analyzing the collected data, the ISO assigns a Public Protection Classification (PPC) on a scale from 1 to 10.

An ISO fire rating is a score provided to fire departments and insurance companies by the Insurance Services Office (ISO). The score reflects how prepared a community is for fires, and assists insurance companies with insurance rates.

City of Fowler's current rating is a 4; Fresno County Fire is a 3.

Other Activities

Wednesday Nights at the Park - We either had a booth or an Engine present to greet the public.

Fire Equipment - All fire apparatuses are being inspected and maintained.
